It was agreed that the deputy clerk would chase the other two companies for their quotes.

- 18. To discuss the street naming of the development of three houses behind Stamford House After a discussion it was RESOLVED to accept the name of Wellingtonia Gardens as suggested by SKDC
- 19. To discuss the correspondence from a resident regarding the taxi rank in the Market Place and decide next steps

The correspondence was read out by the deputy clerk and after a discussion it was proposed by Cllr Gamble, seconded by Cllr Mrs Redshaw and unanimously agreed that that the deputy clerk would enquire about the rules of use of the taxi rank. This item would also be discussed at the meeting with Kevin Brumfield

20. To update members on correspondence regarding the corner of Blenheim Way and to decide the next steps

The deputy clerk informed members that she had not yet received an update on the road safety survey but would chase the results. It was also agreed that this item would be discussed at the meeting with Kevin Brumfield

- 21. Update on the pedestrian crossing on Godsey Lane (near to the primary school / John Eve Field) regarding children's safety when using the crossing. This will be upgraded in the summer
- 22. Footpath 4: Update on the condition and progress being made by SKDC regarding the town councils comments and to discuss the response to Phil Jordan re the cycle path

An email had been received from Phil Jordan at SKDC enquiring whether the cycle path had been implemented on this footpath according to the plans. Cllr Brookes had written a reply and it was proposed by Cllr Gamble, seconded by Cllr Brookes and **RESOLVED** unanimously that this report should be sent back.

The deputy clerk informed the members that she had spoken to Andrea Philpotts at LCC regarding the footpath and that changes would be made but the path could not have tarmac due to the tree roots. Cllr Brookes reported that he had received a similar reply to his letter to Andy Savage at LCC

23. Walking the footpaths: to agree for adverts to be placed in the Advertiser for the walks on 7<sup>th</sup> June and 5<sup>th</sup> July

It was proposed by Cllr Gamble, seconded by Cllr Brookes and unanimously **RESOLVED** that the adverts should be placed.

Cllr Mrs Redshaw informed members that she would need help with the walk
