### Market Deeping Town Council – Planning and Highways Committee

Cllr Shelton welcomed everyone to the meeting and invited the member of public to speak to address the Committee. The member of the public raised his concerns over planning application no S21/1383. Concerns were raised about a proposed balcony and cherry laurel hedging which could grow to between 4 and 8m and block light.

LCC have confirmed that it has been added to their schedule and it will be cut three times a year, the contractor could not provide a specific date. It is not deemed a safety hazard and therefore they will not be taking immediate action.

The purchase of two interactive speed devices (DF11 MCB model) was discussed and approved at Full Council on 14 July. Further clarification from LCC is being sought from street lighting and as soon as we hear

back from LCC we can proceed with the purchase.
